


UAA 27TH AVIATION POLICY SEMINAR FOR STUDENTS

THE SEMINAR: LEARNING & NETWORKING

The University Aviation Association offers students the opportunity to network with aviation industry leaders and members of Congress during the 2018 UAA Aviation Policy Seminar for Students, taking place the first week in January in Washington, DC. This Seminar is recommended for juniors, seniors, graduate students, or those with a good background in aviation.

- Students and faculty facilitators will spend the week on-site in the nation's capital attending briefings & seminars from the NTSB, the FAA, Congressional staff, and industry associations agencies.
- Students will be able to network with others from across the country and gain valuable exposure to leaders in these organizations.
- Students will have the opportunity to gain a better understanding of how these agencies interact in establishing aviation policy and what job opportunities may be available in the aviation industry.
- Faculty and students will gain valuable insight into how they can participate in the process now and in the future.

LOCATION: THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING

The Holiday Inn Washington – Capitol Hotel

A block of rooms at the Holiday Inn – Capitol is being held for seminar students and faculty. The hotel is located at 550 C Street, S.W., Washington, DC 20024 (Phone (202) 479-4000). A valid credit card number is necessary for room reservations.

The Holiday Inn – Capitol lodging rates are based on \$149.00 per night/per room plus 14.5% tax. Parking, if needed, is an additional \$37.50/day (tax included). The rooms have two queen beds. NOTE: A "hold" may be placed on the credit card at check-in for the entire stay.
