

EUGENE S. KROPF SCHOLARSHIP

The University Aviation Association annually awards a \$500 scholarship to applicants who are enrolled in an aviation-related curriculum at a UAA member college or university. Awards will be made to U.S. citizens without regard to gender, race, religion, or national origin.

Candidate Requirements:

- 1) Applicant must be a U.S. citizen.
- 2) Applicant must be enrolled in and plan to continue a college curriculum leading to a two-year or four-year degree in the field of aviation. Proof of enrollment must be provided prior to distribution of award.
- 3) At the time of application, the applicant must be officially enrolled in a UAA member institution in an aviation-related program.
- 4) Applicant must have a cumulative undergraduate grade point average of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale. Upon submitting scholarship application an official transcript from the applicant's college or university must be included.
- 5) The completed application must be accompanied by a 250-word typed, double-spaced paper on "How Can I Improve Aviation Education".
- 6) The completed application and required documents must be postmarked no later than May 31 to be considered for the scholarship.
