

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION DEADLINE IS MAY 31, 2012
EUGENE S. KROPF SCHOLARSHIP

The University Aviation Association annually awards a \$500 scholarship to applicants who are enrolled in an aviation-related curriculum at a UAA member college or university and have achieved sophomore status at the institution. Awards will be made to U.S. citizens without regard to gender, race, religion, or national origin.

Candidate Requirements:

- 1) Applicant must be a U.S. citizen.
- 2) Applicant must be enrolled in and plan to continue a college curriculum leading to a two-year, four-year, or post-graduate degree in the field of aviation. Proof of enrollment must be provided prior to distribution of award.
- 3) At the time of application, the applicant must be officially enrolled in a UAA member institution in an aviation-related program. Member must have completed 30 or more credit hours (or the equivalent for Sophomore status) at the UAA institution and must include the institution's UAA number with the application.
- 4) Applicant must have a cumulative undergraduate grade point average of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale. Upon submitting a scholarship application, an unofficial transcript from the applicant's college or university is acceptable and must be included. After an award recipient is selected, the proposed recipient will be asked to provide an official transcript prior to award distribution.
- 5) The completed application must be accompanied by a 250-word typed, double-spaced paper on **"How Can I Improve Aviation Education"**. Please be direct and focused on the topic.
- 6) The completed application and required documents must be **RECEIVED** no later than **May 31** to be considered for the scholarship. Preferred method will be an electronically scanned copy of your application in PDF format e-mailed to kuhlmank@mscd.edu. In subject line please use "2012 EUGENE S. KROPF SCHOLARSHIP application for "insert your name". Please use "delivery confirmation" options with your e-mail and ask for the recipient's verification. If mail is used, please send an unfolded original with at least 4 unfolded copies of all materials. Make special note that your mail will go through a University mail distribution system that could possibly delay deliveries up to 2-3 weeks. It would be advisable to set a personal deadline **3 weeks prior to May 31st if you use** normal mail systems.
